Explain how 'your' share a common sound of '..aw' as in 'paw'

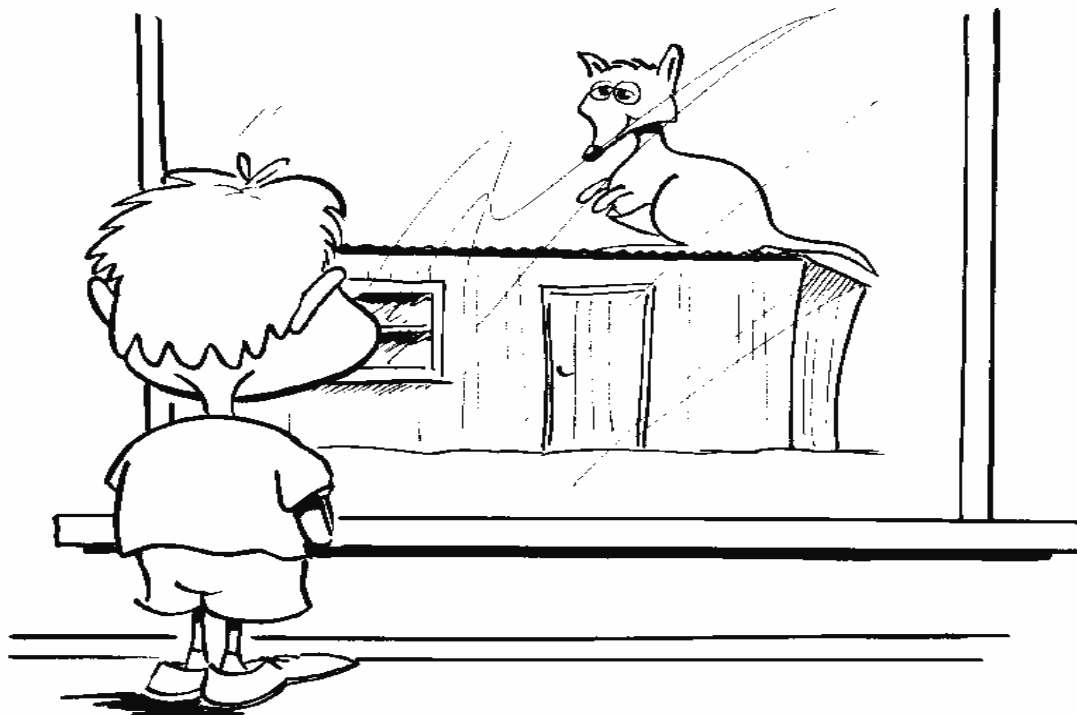
Explain how 'one' makes a sound like 'won'

Long Vowel : 'a' as in 'cake'

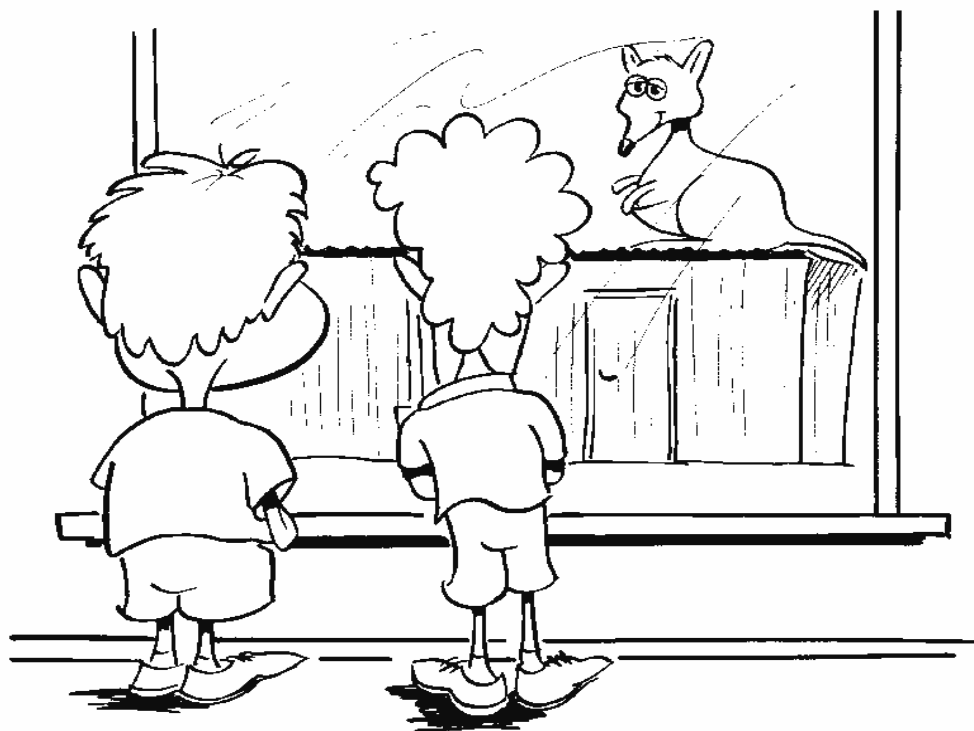
