Help the child to decode the syllables as discussed in Story 31.


#### **Phonic Decoding**

Explain how 'sack', 'back' share a common Sound of '..ack' Explain how 'mole', 'hole' share a common Sound of '..ole'


Explain silent 'e' as in 'mole', 'hole' - making a long vowel 'o' sound.
